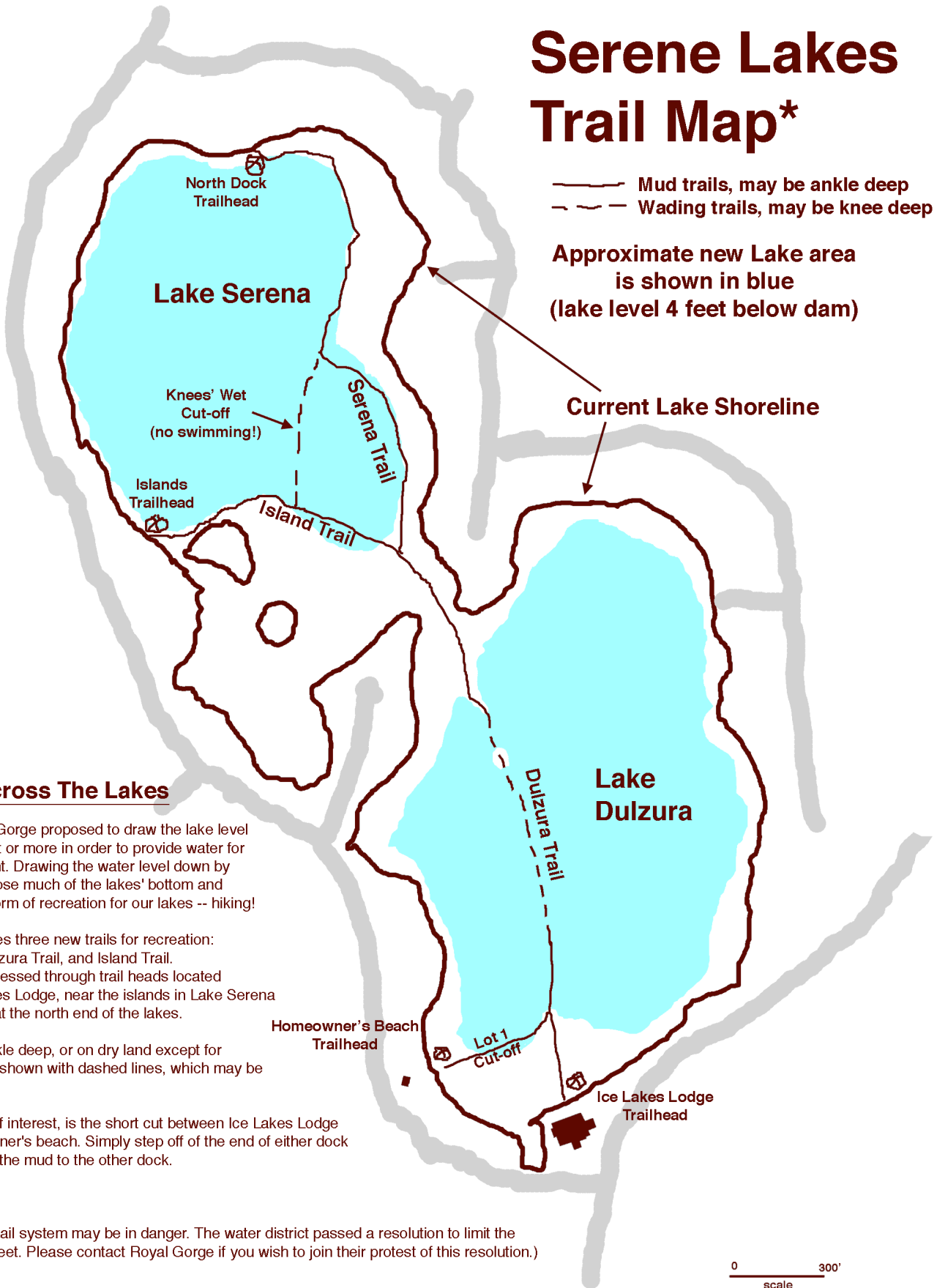


Serene Lakes Trail Map*

A Stroll Across The Lakes

Last May Royal Gorge proposed to draw the lake level down by four feet or more in order to provide water for their development. Drawing the water level down by four feet will expose much of the lakes' bottom and open up a new form of recreation for our lakes -- hiking!

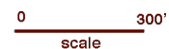
This map identifies three new trails for recreation: Serena Trail, Dulzura Trail, and Island Trail. Trails can be accessed through trail heads located at Lot-1, Ice Lakes Lodge, near the islands in Lake Serena and at the dock at the north end of the lakes.

The trails are ankle deep, or on dry land except for the trail sections shown with dashed lines, which may be knee deep.

Not shown, but of interest, is the short cut between Ice Lakes Lodge and the Homeowner's beach. Simply step off of the end of either dock and walk across the mud to the other dock.
